ELIGIBILITY RULES FOR NOMINATION AND ELECTION OF OFFICERS

ARTICLE 8

8.3 NO MEMBER SHALL BE A CANDIDATE FOR OR HOLD MORE THAN ONE (1) ELECTED OFFICE AT THE SAME TIME.

8.4 (a) IN ORDER TO QUALIFY AS A CANDIDATE FOR ANY ELECTED OFFICE IN THE LOCAL UNION, A MEMBER SHALL BE REQUIRED:

- i. TO HAVE BEEN A MEMBER CONTINUOUSLY IN THIS LOCAL AND THE PREDECESSOR LOCAL TO THIS LOCAL IN THE INTERNATIONAL UNION OF BRICKLAYERS AND ALLIED CRAFTWORKERS FOR A PERIOD OF TWO (2) YEARS IMMEDIATELY PRIOR TO NOMINATIONS; AND
- ii. TO BE CURRENT IN THE PAYMENT OF THEIR DUES, PROVIDED THAT THE BUSINESS MANAGER/FINANCIAL SECRETARY SHALL ACCEPT PAYMENT OF ANY DUES IN ARREARS AT THE NOMINATION MEETING.
- iii. TO ATTEND AT LEAST SEVENTY-FIVE PERCENT (75%) OF THE MEMBERSHIP MEETINGS IN THE YEAR PRIOR TO NOMINATIONS. (AS PER LOCAL CONSTITUTION)
